Celebrate Independence Day in the nation's capital. Minister to tourists, locals, and veterans through music concerts located in the center of DC including the Museum of the Bible World Stage Theater.

Itinerary

DAY 1 - Tuesday, July 2, 2024

Depart for Washington, D.C. (flights not included). Upon arrival, meet the group at the airport and travel by bus to Arlington National Cemetery, an enduring tribute of sacrifice. Pay respects at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and stop at the grave of John F. Kennedy and the Eternal Flame. See additional sacred sites and memorials as time permits. Transfer to hotel for check in. Free time until rehearsal and dinner (included) at hotel.



DAY 2 - Wednesday, July 3, 2024

After breakfast, walk the short distance to the Museum of the Bible for a group tour, then free time to begin exploring the 400,000+ sq ft museum to learn ways the Bible has impacted history and culture for over 3000 years. Examine 7 floors of artifacts, treasures and ancient Scriptures on display in addition to high-tech, interactive and engaging exhibitions and virtual experiences. Begin rotation of singing in the atrium. Lunch with payment on own. Return to hotel to refresh for God & Country evening concert at Museum of the Bible World Stage Theater. Dinner included.



DAY 3 - Thursday, July 4, 2024

After breakfast, depart for a prayer walk along the National Mall with view of the Washington Monument, White House, Lincoln Memorial and more. Lunch with payment on own. Gather and sing at David's Tent, 24/7 worship and prayer ministry since 2015, on the National Mall. Continue to Capitol Hill for prayer for the three branches of government. Tour the Capitol with a special moment of singing in the Rotunda. Free evening for dinner on your own and time to enjoy the nation's birthday festivities including late evening fireworks (approximately 9p).



DAY 4 - Friday, July 5, 2024

Enjoy breakfast, then head out for a day of ministry and missions. Go to a veteran's organization for time of visitation and concert. Lunch with payment on own. Ministry continues in the afternoon by providing helping hands and a life-changing message of love and hope to a local organization. Support could include light labor or working in a food pantry or clothes closet with time for a worship concert. Dinner (included).

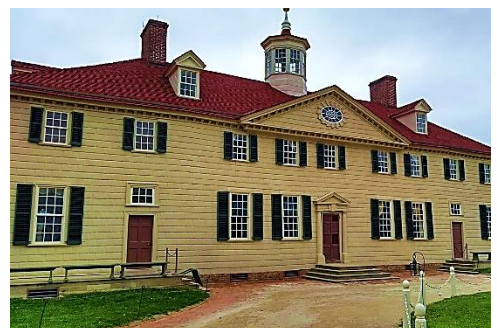


DAY 5 - Saturday, July 6, 2024

Following breakfast, enjoy free time to visit the Smithsonian Museums or leisure time to explore the metropolitan area. Lunch with payment on own.

Optional half-day excursion to Mount Vernon, the 500-acre estate of George Washington, America's first president. Tour the mansion and explore the grounds and gardens to learn about life during the colonial era. Price of excursion is an additional cost. Lunch with payment on own.
